Carry me on within your memories.

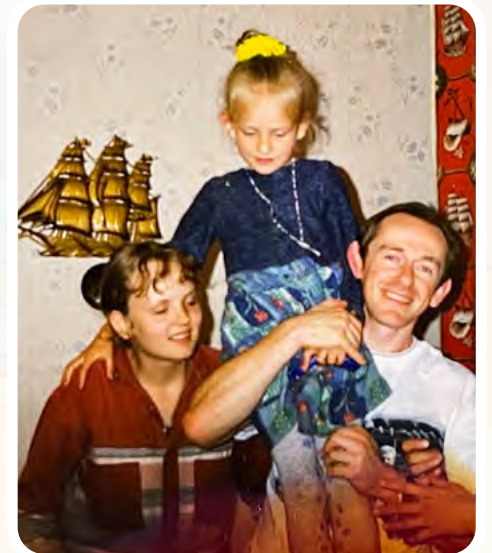
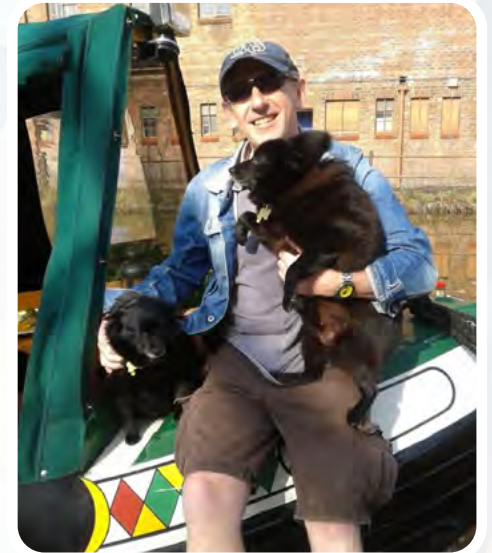
